

DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS AFFAIRS GI BILL INFORMATION

1. Flight training benefits are available to eligible active duty, veterans and reservists under:
 - A. Chapters 30 (Montgomery GI Bill) and 32 (VEAP), Title 38 USC
 - B. Chapters 1606 (SELRES) & 1607 (MOBILIZATION) Title 10 USC.
2. **Only Part 141** training for combined instrument/commercial or commercial courses are eligible for benefits. **GI Bill does not pay for Private Pilot training.** Instrument training only reimbursable when concurrently enrolled in Commercial Pilot course, or a combined Instrument/Commercial Course.
3. Students must hold an **unrestricted Private Pilot Certificate** and at least a **CURRENT Class II** medical certificate **prior to enrollment** to be eligible for benefits. **(If this is not done, NO BENEFITS)**
4. Program reimburses the Veteran for up to 60% of VA approved part 141 ground training, dual and solo flight training, simulator training plus pre/post flight briefings. Reimbursable amount can not exceed benefit limit.
5. All aircraft in Europe-American Aviation's fleet are approved for training. Our Level 5 Flight Training Device is approved as well.
6. Processing:
 - A. Student must file Form 22-1990 (Application for VA Education benefits) if benefits have never been used, or Form 22-1995 (change of program or place of training request). These are available online at:

 - B. School certifies Form 22-1999 (Enrollment Certification)
 - C. School certifies Form 22-6553c (Monthly Certification of Flight Training) so the student can get reimbursed per VA regulations.
